

# CM flags off mobile therapy vans

Patna: Chief minister Nitish Kumar on Thursday launched mobile therapy vans which would provide basic medical assistance to elderly people, widows and others who require social security.

The CM flagged off the vans, launched under 'Buniyadi Sanjivani Sewa' scheme, at a function in the presence of deputy CM Sushil Kumar Modi and social welfare minister Kumari Manju Verma. Sources said altogether 11 vans would visit different districts, including Nalanda, Patna, Bhagalpur, Begusarai, Buxar, Muzaffarpur etc. "The vans are equipped with basic medical apparatus and will have technical teams which would provide medical care to elderly people, widows and specially-abled persons," said a source, adding the vans are supported by World Bank and Bihar government.
